# 2017 DNR Floodplain Program Update

#### **DNR Floodplain Mapping Program**

- Iron County Map Modernization (County Wide)
  - Kick off Meeting on February 10<sup>th</sup> in Hurley.
  - DNR is only funded through FEMA for the work maps and Community Engagement Meeting. Currently not funded for the preliminary maps.
- Lafayette County Map Modernization (County Wide)
  - o Kick off meeting on February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2017
  - DNR is only funded through FEMA for the work maps and Community Engagement Meeting. Currently not funded for the preliminary maps.
- Lake Wausau Physical Map Revision (PMR)
  - Communities impacted are Marathon County, City of Schofield, Village of Rothschild,
     Village of Weston, and City of Wausau
  - o Revisions are on 6 panels
  - o Open House for Community Officials is on February 9<sup>th</sup> in Wausau.

#### Hoods Creek PMR

- Communities impacted are Racine County, City of Racine, Village of Sturtevant, Village of Caledonia, and Village of Mount Pleasant.
- o Revisions are on 8 panels
- o The anticipated preliminary map release date is February 14, 2017
- o Projected final FIRM map release is November 2017
- An Open House for the preliminary maps will be in April 2017

#### Black River Falls PMR

- o Communities impacted are Jackson County and City of Black River Falls
- o Revisions are to 1 panel to certify a levee.
- o Had preliminary meeting in December of 2016
- o Final release date of March 29, 2017 with effective date of September 29, 2017

# Fort McCoy PMR

- o Community impacted is Monroe County
- o Revision are to 8 current panels
- o Currently in the preliminary mapping stage

### Upper Fox Watershed

- Communities impacted are Kenosha, Racine, Walworth, Waukesha plus cities and villages.
- Had flood risk review and resilience meetings in May 2016
- DNR is only funded to create preliminary maps but not funded to releasing them.
- o No future meetings scheduled at this time.

# Milwaukee Watershed

- Communities impacted Milwaukee metro area plus Washington, Ozaukee, Waukesha,
   Fond du Lac, and Sheboygan Counties
- o DNR only funded through the data development phase
- Flood Risk Review meetings and resilience meeting in late 2017. Kickapoo Watershed
  - o Communities that are impacted, Vernon, Richland, Monroe and Crawford County.

- DNR only funded through the Discovery Phase
- o Phone conference with communities in Summer/Fall 2017
- o Final discovery meeting estimated in February of 2018
- Upper Fox River Inundation Mapping
  - o Communities impacted are Waukesha and Walworth
  - o Final stakeholder meeting in Spring of 2017
- Milwaukee River Inundation Mapping
  - o Kick off Meeting in Spring/Summer 2017
  - o Currently in the data development stage, gauges not selected yet
- Great Lakes Coastal Study
  - Lake Michigan work maps Summer of 2017
  - Lake Michigan preliminary maps Summer of 2018
  - Lake Superior work maps Summer of 2018
  - Mapping is being conducted through private contractors of FEMA.
  - Several meetings throughout the Lake Michigan region
  - o DNR working on coastal floodplain ordinance language throughout the summer

All dates and projects subject to changed due to funding and/or any appeals.

## Floodplain Management Update

Michelle Staff will be contacting new NR116/floodplain chairman on updates and issues regarding floodplain.

- Cranberry Model Ordinance
  - Language has been completed
  - o Public Comment will be in February 2017
  - With final release of ordinance estimated in June 2017
- Federal/State/Local Transportation Projects
  - DNR has been working with DOT on a cooperative agreement to included floodplain study requirements. Outreach has started in the transportation community with WCA, DOT, Wisconsin State Highway Commissioner and WCCA.
  - o Possible future meetings with all stakeholders to come to a resolution on this issue.
- Campground Work Group
  - DNR will be inviting a stakeholders to be a part of the work group to talk about accessory structures within floodplain campgrounds.
- Summer 2017 Coastal Model Ordinance work will start
